STROUDSBURG EMERGENCY MORTGAGE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM
APPLICATION DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 26, 2021

In conjunction with the U.S. Housing and Urban Development and Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development, the Borough of Stroudsburg is providing grant funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic. Funding is available under the CARES Act funding from the Borough of Stroudsburg’s Community Development Block Grant – COVID-19.



The **Stroudsburg Emergency Mortgage Assistance Grant Program** will provide eligible applicants the following:

- Minimum **three (3) months** of mortgage assistance.
- Maximum monthly mortgage assistance of **\$1,000 per month** (principal & interest ONLY).
- Form of assistance from the grant will be paid directly to the mortgage company.

The Stroudsburg Emergency Assistance Grant Program will be a one-time assistance grant for eligible Stroudsburg Borough residents. Funding is limited. Applications will be accepted on a first-ready, first-served basis.

Qualifications:

- Reside within the Borough of Stroudsburg **ONLY**. (Residents in the following communities are not eligible under the Stroudsburg Emergency Mortgage Assistance: Monroe County non-entitlement municipalities and East Stroudsburg Borough. Please visit their respective websites for their own Emergency Mortgage Assistance Grant Program.)

- **At the time of application**, have a current annual household income that does not exceed 80% of Area Median Income (AMI) as shown in chart.
- Have experienced an economic impact because of the COVID-19 pandemic (job loss, furlough or reduction in hours of pay).
- Have a current mortgage agreement for a housing unit located in Stroudsburg Borough, Monroe County, PA.
- All applicants shall certify that the applicant is not able to receive and have not received other sources of assistance from any private, local, state, or federal funding source for the same requested mortgage assistance (known as Duplication of Benefits).
