This notice shall satisfy two (2) separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the County of Monroe.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about January 16, 2019, Monroe County will request that the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) for the release of 2017 Community Development Block Grant Program funds under the provisions of Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, to undertake projects known as 2017 CDBG, for the purpose of carrying a Community Development Program for the following projects:

MONROE COUNTY

14A HOUSING REHABILITATION

Purpose/Description:

A multi-year program to provide financial assistance for rehabilitation of owner-occupied, low/moderate income, single family dwellings.

Location:

County-wide except East Stroudsburg Borough and Borough of Stroudsburg

Cost:

\$237,838 in FY 2017 CDBG Funds

BOROUGH OF STROUDSBURG

O3K STREET IMPROVEMENTS

Purpose/Description:

Repair and/or replacement of curb and ramp at all impacted intersections that do not meet current standards and requirements.

Location:

King Street Improvement Project, Borough of Stroudsburg

Cost:

\$ 76,743 in FY 2017 CDBG Funds

BOROUGH OF EAST STROUDSBURG

O3L SIDEWALKS – Borough-wide

Purpose/Description:

Curb-cut ADA Ramp Project

Location:

East Stroudsburg Borough – various scattered sites

Cost:

\$104,176 in FY 2017 CDBG Funds

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The County of Monroe has determined that the projects will have no significant adverse impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Monroe office located at 701 Main Street, Suite 502, Stroudsburg, PA and may be examined or copied weekdays 8:30AM to 4:30PM.

PUBLIC COMMENTS ON FINDING

Any individual, group or agency disagreeing with this determination or wishing to comment on the projects may submit written comments to the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Monroe, 701 Main Street, Suite 502, Stroudsburg, PA 18360. All comments received by 4:30pm, January 15, 2019, will be considered by the County of Monroe prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which part of the CDBG Notice they are addressing.

RELEASE OF FUNDS

The County of Monroe certifies to DCED that John R. Moyer, Board of Commissioners, serving in the capacity as Chairman, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. DCED's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows Monroe County to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

DCED will accept objections to its release of funds and the County of Monroe's certification for a period of 18 days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following basis: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the County of Monroe; (b) the County of Monroe has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient has committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by DCED; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactorily from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to Department of Community and Economic Development, Commonwealth Keystone Building, 4th Floor, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120-0225. Potential objections should contact DCED to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
